



DO NOT INSTALL Illegal Mobile Phone Signal Boosters

Self-installation and use of cellular repeaters (commonly known as “mobile phone signal boosters”) will cause harmful interference to the public mobile networks, and is illegal in Hong Kong.



Under the Telecommunications Ordinance (Cap. 106), it is an offence to establish, maintain, possess or use any unauthorised mobile phone signal booster. Any person guilty of it shall be liable to a fine of HK\$50,000 and imprisonment for two years.



If members of the public experience any problem of the reception of public mobile service, they should report it to their mobile network operators for improvement, or contact the hotline of the Office of the Communications Authority at **2961 6333** for assistance.

Some individuals have self-installed mobile phone signal boosters alleging to increase the signal level of the public mobile services for better reception by themselves. However, such unauthorised boosters interfere with the normal operation of radio base stations in the vicinity used by mobile network operators for the provision of public mobile services, and would adversely affect reception of the public mobile services by other users.
